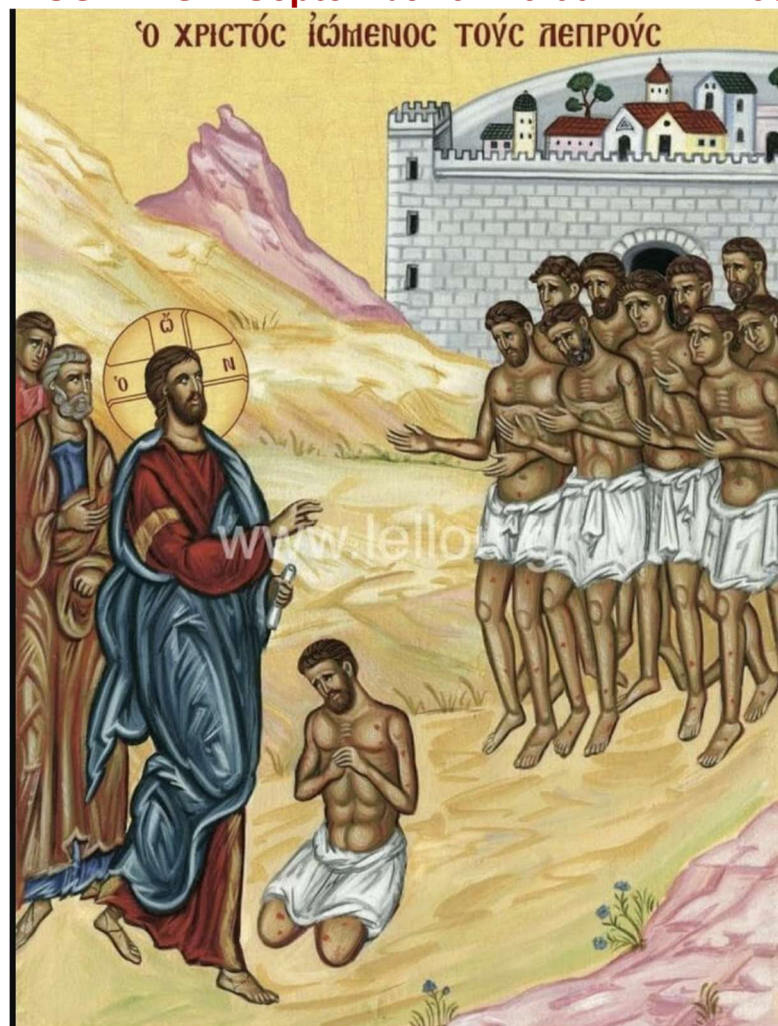

The Epistle Galatians 5:16-24

Brethren, But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. ¹⁷ For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do. ¹⁸ But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. ¹⁹ Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, ²¹ envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the Kingdom of God. ²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. ²⁴ And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke, the 17th Chapter:11-19

Now it happened at that time On the way to Jerusalem He was passing along between Samaria and Galilee. ¹² And as He entered a village, He was met by ten lepers, who stood at a distance ¹³ and lifted up their voices, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us." ¹⁴ When He saw them He said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they went they were cleansed. ¹⁵ Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice; ¹⁶ and he fell on his face at Jesus' feet, giving him thanks. Now he was a Samaritan. ¹⁷ Then Jesus answered, "Were not ten cleansed? Where are the nine? ¹⁸ Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?" ¹⁹ And He said to him, "Rise and go your way; your faith has made you well."

Sermon St. Luke 17:11-19 OH, GIVE THANKS TO THE LORD, FOR HE IS GOOD!

The Theme of Today's Liturgy Trinity-14 Gospel: To "walk in the Spirit" means to be thankful for all God's blessings. **Introit:** Those who walk in the Spirit, however, hunger to be in the LORD's presence and look forward to seeing His face. **Gradual** [/& **Alleluia Verse**]: That faith leads us to give thanks to the LORD and praise Him within the walls of Zion. **Collect:** So our prayer is that the LORD would rescue us from the destructive desires of our flesh. We also pray that He would lead us to give thanks and glorify Him for all things that are "profitable for our salvation."
